DO NOT use a parallel interface cable that is longer than 2 meters (6 feet). Use a shielded interface cable that is IEEE 1284-compliant.

Use a straight-through Category 5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.
